How to Put the Ghost 2 Immobiliser into Service Mode



Service Mode allows the vehicle to be used without needing the Ghost Code, which is useful if the car is being serviced or similar. This allows you to hand over the vehicle without giving the Ghost Code.

If the vehicle is driven over 30mph for more than 15 minutes, the Ghost is automatically removed from Service Mode and will require the Code the next time the vehicle is started. Ensure to establish this if there is a possibility the car could be used in this aspect.

Enter your Code to disable Service Mode and return the Ghost to normal functions.

Service mode doesn't apply for users with a Ghost Tag.

Following are the most common ways to activate Service Mode, as activating Service Mode can vary depending on the make and model of your car. The information specific to your car is explained in the handover after installation.

For: Audi, Cupra, Seat, Mercedes, Vauxhall

- 1. Open the car and enter your code.
- 2. Wait for the 2 flashes.
- 3. Floor the accelerator pedal and press the Driver's Window Up button 5 times.

For: Range Rover Sport 2019

- 1. Open the car and enter your code.
- 2. Wait for the 2 flashes.
- 3. Flash High Beams and press the Cancel Cruise Control button 5 times.
